What is Changing

The program will still provide two simulation events each year:

- November
- January

However, individual one-to-one feedback will be replaced with group education sessions held off-ice.

Why This Change Is Being Made

Group sessions allow:

- More consistent information for all participants
- A supportive learning environment
- Broader education about competition expectations
- Provides targeted education focused on the needs of developing skaters.

What the New Sessions Will Include

Education sessions will focus on what officials notice and evaluate during competitions, including:



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- Warm-up time management
- Hair and makeup presentation
- Appropriate warm-up clothing
- Program presentation and requirements
- Competition readiness and performance presentation
