CanSkate Regional (DC) 30L – 9577

Under the Saskatchewan Ministry of Education Dual Credit Initiative Certified CanSkate and Certified Regional (CanSkate Regional) Coach will be recognized for credit towards Grade 12 after August 1st, 2024.

This program recognizes the 100+ hours of education and training for Certified CanSkate and Certified Regional Coaches. It recognizes the work and dedication of those who strive to step on the ice to engage Saskatchewan lives through skating.

Every Coach who certifies as a CanSkate and/or Regional Coach in Saskatchewan after August 1st, 2024, can be recognized for one (1) credit towards satisfying their Grade 12 requirements. No forms to fill out and no plans to get approved prior to taking your CanSkate and/or Regional Coach.

Anyone who is working towards their Grade 12 requirements in Saskatchewan can use this program including:

- High School students can earn credit towards graduation while working towards their first career.
- Those who are returning to complete their Grade 12 requirements can earn credit towards graduation and become certified to begin a new career.
- Those new to Canada can earn credit towards Grade 12.

Steps to Receiving Credit for CanSkate Coach 30 L

1. Ensure you have all the prerequisites for CanSkate Coach
 - 15 years of age
 - one (1) complete STAR 5 Assessment or higher
 - if you do not meet this prerequisite, please contact Skate Saskatchewan
 - current registered member of Skate Canada
2. Enroll the CanSkate Coach course.
 - Complete Skate Canada eLearning Part A Coaching Foundations
 - Complete Skate Canada eLearning Part B CanSkate Foundations
3. Take the CanSkate Coach course.
 - Upon successful completion you will receive In-Training status. You can now register as a Coach with Skate Canada to begin your coaching career.
 - Skate Canada registration will require the following to be completed:
 - First Aid
 - Respect in Sport (Skate Canada eLearning)
 - BackCheck through Skate Canada (18 years of age & older)
 - You are eligible for the Regional Coach course, providing you meet the prerequisites.
4. Take required multi-sport modules through Coaches Association of Saskatchewan
 - Make Ethical Decisions (including online evaluation)
 - Teaching & Learning

5. Enroll and complete the CanSkate Evaluation Portfolio through Skate Canada
 - Enroll in this course only when you are prepared to finish the portfolio in a timely manner.
6. Certified CanSkate Coach – Congratulations!
7. Take your certification email from Skate Canada to your school and request credit for CanSkate Coach 30L.
 - Course Name - CanSkate Coach (DC) 30L
 - Course ID – 9576
 - Ensure your school administrator enters Standing Grade (SD) for the overall mark on the transcript.

Congratulations you are one (1) credit closer to graduating.

Steps to Receiving Credit for Regional (CanSkate Regional) Coach 30 L

1. Ensure you have all the prerequisites for Regional Coach
 - Be a current Skate Canada registrant with Skate Canada or a registered coach in good standing.
 - One (1) complete STAR 6 Assessment or STAR 5 Free Skate Assessment plus one (1) additional STAR 5 Assessment
 - Completed two (2) day in-person CanSkate Coach course.
2. Enroll the Regional Coach course.
 - Complete Skate Canada eLearning Part C Regional Foundations
3. Take the Regional Coach course.
 - Upon successful completion you will receive In-Training status.
4. Take required multi-sport module through Coaches Association of Saskatchewan
 - Plan a Practice
5. Enroll and complete the certification option that best suits your coaching needs. Enroll in this course only when you are prepared to finish the portfolio in a timely manner.
 - Option #1 – CanSkate and Regional Coach Hybrid Certified Coach Portfolio
 - Option #2 – Regional Coach Certified Portfolio
6. Certified CanSkate and Regional Coach or Certified Regional Coach – Congratulations!
7. Take your certification email from Skate Canada to your school and request credit for CanSkate Coach 30L (course name and ID above) and/or CanSkate Regional Coach 30L.
 - Course Name - CanSkate Regional Coach (DC) 30L
 - Course ID – 9577
 - Ensure your school administrator enters Standing Grade (SG) for the overall mark on the transcript.
